Hagerty Drive it Day Tour - Silverstone to Donington

Glittering classics gathered at the Silverstone Racing Club bright and early ready for a bacon sarnie and a quick cuppa before heading off on the 82-mile tour through scenic Northants and Leicestershire to take part in the Hagerty tour. Now an annual event, it raised money this year for the Hope against Cancer and Motorsport Safety Fund charities.

From pre-WW2 Austin Seven and Alvis Speed 20 through classic staples such as Escort Mexicos, Triumph TRs and MGs to exotic Maseratis, Jensens, Corvettes, BMW M3 and Colin Mullan's drop-dead gorgeous Monteverdi 375L. The winding route took participants from Britain's F1 track past the Althorp estate where Princess Diana is buried and on to Naseby where the New Model Army destroyed King Charles I field army in 1645. Cars stopped to see the battle monument and enjoy the views across the fields where the result of the Civil War were fought. Husband's Bosworth Gliding centre provided a reminder of the WW2 bomber airfield, then the cars flowed on past Ibstock Brick to reach the finish outside the entrance to Kevin Wheatcroft's Donington Collection.
