You can cancel your entry up to the closing date of 15th August and we will return the majority of your entry fee. However, a donation of £25.00 per crew will sent to Kent, Surrey & Sussex Air Ambulance and £5 per entry will be retained by Bognor Regis Motor Club for administration costs.

The charity's aircraft are based and maintained at Redhill Aerodrome in Surrey. Its headquarters and forward operating base are at Rochester Airport in Kent.
